Research All About It!

Use the internet or a book to research the vocabulary word. Record 3 things things you didn't know about the word/topic. This activity is meant to enrich/expand knowledge of the Social Studies vocabulary.

Be sure to thoroughly explain what you learned about each word (a sentence or 2 for each word is fine). Record the resource where you got the information from under each sentence.

USE FIVE (5) VOCAB WORDS.

Words in Action

UseFIVE (5) of your vocabulary words to write a letter, story, article, or poem. Your writing should make sense and should have historical context as these are all Social Studies words! Make sure you highlight or underline all of your words. Be as creative as you can!

Doing this activity well can possibly earn you an EXTRA 100% homework grade!!

Gamer

Create a Trivia Game in your notebook asking a question about each vocabulary word. Use post-its to write the question (highlight the vocabulary word), and then lift the flap to find an answer. The questions should not be. "What does _____ mean?" The question should reflect the context (meaning) of the word, not just ask for a definition. Show what you know! USE FIVE (5) VOCAB WORDS.

Example: Word: migrate

<u>Trivia Question:</u> Explain why geese **migrate** south each winter.

<u>Answer:</u> Geese migrate south each winter to escape cold weather. They fly to warmer climates where food is plentiful and they are able to survive. Once cold weather, ends geese migrate north for the remainder of the year.

Comic-Con


